Module 3. The specifics of scientific training in Georgia and possibilities of international scientific cooperation. Writing a scientific paper and publishing scientific results. Student scientific schools and communities of young scientists.

Module 4. Science as the basis of the educational process – in the direction of each participant.

1. Studying the organizational structure of the university and training programs for the specialties “History and Archeology” and “International Relations” through access to the official website of the university.

2. Acquaintance with the methodological support of specialties.

3. Studying the experience of distance education and distance learning.
