Requirements for the design of materials

- Theses are no more than 5 pages in A4 page format, portrait orientation.
- Margins: top, bottom, right and left – 20 mm.
- Font – Times New Roman, font size – 14.
- Line spacing – 1.5.
- Paragraph indentation – 1.25 cm.
- Width alignment.
- Last name, first name, patronymic of the scientist, place of work or study – on the right side of the page.
- The title of the report in the middle of the page (in capital letters, without a period at the end).
- List of references - no more than 5.

Please proofread your materials as carefully as possible for literacy, style and logic of presentation! Remember: all materials published in the collection are submitted in the author's edition.
